# What is the training about?



The training aims to help people with learning disabilities understand what hate and mate crime is and where to report it.



We will look at examples of hate and mate crime to help them understand what it means.



We will talk about people's differences – and celebrate them!



We will give people information about where they can report hate crime.

# How will the training be run?



The training is aimed at people with learning disabilities. We can deliver it to a large group or a small group.



The workshop lasts for 2 hours.



It includes a range of activities, such as group discussions and a quiz.



We can deliver the training where your group meet. Or we can book a room in a community venue, but you will need to meet the cost of this. There is no other charge for our training.
